APPLICANT CRITERIA

ACLF seeks to attract a diverse set of candidates from private, public and non-profit sectors

1. Individuals with a strong commitment to social justice, community empowerment and public service;
2. Individuals who have an interest and desire in positively impacting their communities; and
3. Individuals who genuinely wish to further enhance and develop their leadership skills.
 - o **All accepted applicants are required to attend an opening retreat scheduled for Fri, May 14 - Sun, May 16, 2010. Attendance is mandatory.**
 - o **PARTICIPATING IN THE COMMUNITY LEADERS PROGRAM INVOLVES A SERIOUS, ONGOING TIME COMMITMENT.** Accepted applicants must strongly commit to attending regularly scheduled sessions on the second and fourth Thursdays of the month between May – October, starting in mid May, from 5:30 - 8:30 pm. In addition to these sessions, accepted applicants complete a group community project that requires substantial time spent outside of regularly scheduled sessions. Participants are expected to commit an average of 10 hours/month to ACLF activities.
 - o If accepted, there is a \$200 program fee in order to cover materials. Scholarship opportunities are available to honor our commitment to program accessibility and diversity.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Please respond to the following **short essay** questions (Limit short essay response to one page per question):
 - o What do you hope to gain from your participation in ACLF’s Community Leaders Program (CLP)?
 - o What will you contribute as a participant in the CLP? How will your personal and professional experience be of value to your colleagues in the program?
 - o How do you define your “community?” – What is it that you most value deeply about it? Why?
2. **Attach a current resume.**
3. **Submit one letter of recommendation.**
4. **Cost:** No application fee required.

APPLICATION TIMELINE & SUBMISSION

Applications to the CLP program are now accepted on a rolling basis:

- o To be considered for CLP 2010, applications must be postmarked or emailed by **Fri, March 12, 2010**.
- o Those selected to be interviewed need to be available on Saturday, April 17, 2010.
- o Acceptance Notification: Late April 2010 – All accepted applicants are required to attend an opening retreat scheduled for Friday, May 14 - Sunday, May 16, 2010. Attendance is mandatory.
- o Program Schedule: Mid-May 2010 through early November 2010. Graduation Dinner in early-November 2010.
